## SUMMARY

Exchange is a mail server with calendar, contact, note and task syncing capabilities. It runs exclusively on Microsoft Windows Server operating systems. There is no built-in support for Instant Messaging, Files, Team Chat, Conferences or Recording. Even though Exchange may be extended with similar functionalities, all of them are provided as separate, stand-alone systems at an additional cost and with added hardware and software requirements. One of the limitations is also the necessity to run Microsoft Windows Server OS, whereas with IceWarp you have the choice between Windows Server or Linux OS. In IceWarp, users benefit from its all-in-one interface where all the features are accessible in a single browser window with no need to install additional software.
